HISTORY OF OUR INDIAN CURRENCY

रूपये का इतिहास जरूर पढे. प्राचीन भारतीय मुद्रा प्रणाली अपने बचचौ को जरुर पढायै.

फूटी कौड़ी (Phootie Cowrie) से कौड़ी, कौड़ी से दमड़ी (Damri), दमड़ी से धेला (Dhela), धेला से पाई (Pie), पाई से पैसा (Paisa), पैसा से आना (Aana), आना से रुपया (Rupya) बना। 256 दमड़ी = 192 पाई = 128 धेला = 64 पैसा (old) = 16 आना = 1 रुपया 1) 3 फूटी कौड़ी - 1 कौड़ी

2) 10 कौड़ी - 1 दमड़ी
3) 2 दमड़ी - 1 धेला
4) 1.5 पाई - 1 धेला
5) 3 पाई - 1 पैसा (पुराना)
6) 4 पैसा - 1 आना
7) 16 आना - 1 रुपया
